and methods to enhance the patient provider relationship. Sessions consist of live interviews with patients, role plays, small group learning and general discussion around a case presentation format.

2. *"What Do You Hear? Improving Patient Care in IBD Through Communication"* This is a facilitated learning program created by DrossmanCare in Association with Abbvie Pharmaceuticals. The program is designed to teach communication skills to health care practitioners working in Inflammatory Bowel Disease but it can be used by all medical practitioners. The program consists of a slide presentation, a Workshop Moderator Guide, that contains guidelines for teaching the workshop, and a Participant Workbook. Imbedded in the slide presentation are 3 several minute video vignettes written and produced by DrossmanCare that address ineffective and effective communication skills. In February 2017 Dr. Drossman facilitated a "teach the teacher" workshop for clinicians and behaviorists (psychiatrists and psychologists) on how to moderate a workshop. In addition, Dr. Drossman coordinated the production of 15 filmed interviews on common GI interactions with patients.
